We urge you to join the closed Facebook Group. Send a request to join Christian Science Nursing Association (UK). It is a useful forum and we do want to see it used more.

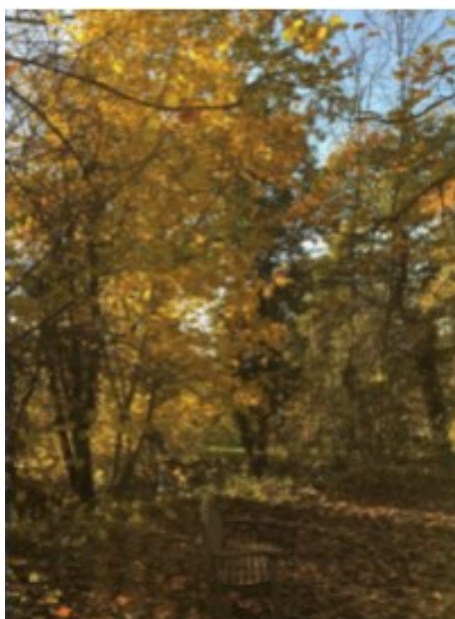
